People usually stick to less bright colors in fall and winter months. But that is not the case for 2021-2022.










Patterns were popular in the Autumn/Winter 21-22 runway shows.

Patterns will never go out of style and I expect to see a lot of them in the upcoming fall and winter months.








## **Cute & Cozy**
